

School Supplies List 2011-2012

Dear parents,

Below you will find a supply list that covers all the grades in the school. In addition, each team asks for some items specific to its grade's needs. Please be sure to check both lists.

Please bring the following items to school on **MEET THE TEACHER DAY** (Monday, August 29th) or the **FIRST DAY OF CLASS** (Tuesday, August 30th) in a **bag** marked with your child's name.

- 2 box of tissues
- 1 container of alcohol-free wet wipes (*these will be used for cleaning, not for children's hands*)
- 1 container of Baby wipes
- **Sharpened** pencils (*Kindergarten – 6th*)
 - *Kindergarten and 1st Grade: 2 packages of 10 – 12 pencils each*
 - *2nd – 6th Grade: 4 packages of 10 – 12 pencils each*
- 3 large glue sticks
- 3 pink erasers (*Kindergarten – 6th*)
- 1 Box of thick washable markers (8 – 10 Assorted colors) (*Kindergarten – 4th*)
- 1 Box of thin washable markers (8 – 10 Assorted colors)
- 1 pair of child scissors (*Pre-K – 4th*)
 - *4th grade – 6 in to 8 in scissors are preferred*
- 2 *kippot* with your child's name clearly marked on each, in a labeled bag (mandatory for boys, optional for girls)
- 1 Pack of *Kippah* clips (mandatory for boys, optional for girls)
- 1 reusable water bottle, labeled with your child's name



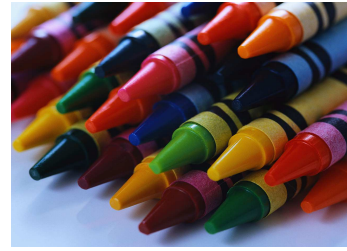
Pre - Kindergarten



On the **FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL**, please bring the following additional materials to school in a bag marked with your child's name. Please do not label individual supplies.

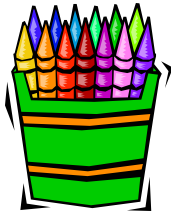
- A large backpack or tote bag with your child's name clearly visible No wheels, please.
- A weather-appropriate change of clothing for your child, including shirt, pants, underwear, and socks. Please label all clothing and put it in a labeled Ziploc bag.
- A 4 x 6 photo of your family in a frame (with a hook or tab on the back) that we can keep for the year and hang in our classroom.
- A Keepsake Bag: during the course of the summer, please help your child find a few special items and put them in a Keepsake Bag, a brown lunch bag labeled with your name. These items should remind the children of their summers. Please join your child in decorating the Keepsake Bag. We will share items with each other during the first few weeks of school.
- *Options:* one cuddle object, like a blanket or stuffed animal, to accompany your child at nap time.

Kindergarten



In order to help make this year fun-filled and successful, we are asking each of you to supply the following additional items on the first day of school:

- A large backpack **labeled** with your child's name
- A change of clothing (appropriate to the weather): a shirt, pants/shorts, underwear, and socks. Please **label** each article of clothing and put it in a **labeled** zip lock bag.
- A favorite stuffed animal to share on the first day of school
- A small bag (3-5 items) of summer treasures to share during the first few weeks of school



1st Grade



Please bring the following additional materials to school in a **bag** marked with your child's name. Please do **not** label individual supplies:

- 1 small box of crayons – 24 crayons per box or less
- 1 additional box of thick washable markers
- 1 package of pencil top erasers
- 2 bottle of Elmer's School Glue (4 oz. size)
- 2 rolls of Scotch tape **in dispensers**
- 1 large children's Hanes white, short sleeved undershirt (or in your child's specific size)

2nd Grade

Please bring the following additional materials to school in a bag marked with your child's name. Please do not label individual supplies *unless otherwise specified*. Supplies will be communal.

- 7 pictures of yourself with or without family members in a *labeled*, sealed envelope
 - Please send in a picture from each year of your child's life. Some pictures should include significant family members and the rest should be of just your child. All pictures should be labeled on the back with the age of your child and who is included. You will not be getting these pictures back.
- 1 of each of the following Highlighters: Yellow, Green, Orange, Blue, Pink
- 1 package of thin dry erase markers



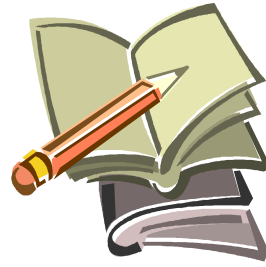
** This type of large *Kippah* does not need clips, and fits snugly on your child's head. If you cannot find large *kippot* or prefer the smaller ones, please bring in 4 extra *kippot* and a package of clips. Thanks in advance!

3rd Grade

- 2 plastic pencil boxes (labeled with your child's name)
- 1 4-pack of fine point dry erase markers
- 1 additional child scissors (Heavy duty)
- 1 small pencil sharpener (holds its own shavings and can fit in the pencil box)
- 1 pack of highlighters that include the colors pink, yellow, blue, and green
- 2 white three ring binders (size 1 inch, hardcover with metal rings in the **center** of the spine, so that it can be opened from both directions)



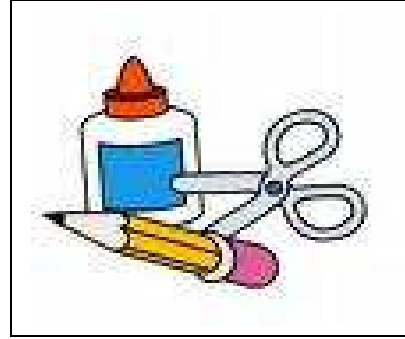
4th Grade

- 1 hard plastic pencil case **labeled and filled with the following:**

 - A plastic, manual pencil sharpener
- 1 soft pencil pouch labeled and filled with:
 - The package of sharpened pencils already requested on the “whole school” supply list
 - 1 package of highlighters

5th Grade



For General Studies:

- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener
- 1 pencil case
- 1 pack of eraser tops
- 1 pack of 4" x 6" index cards
- 1 scotch tape in dispenser
- 2 two-inch binders (please leave one at home for the second semester)
- 2 packs of dividers

For Math (*Ms. Taitz and Ms. Schopf's classes*):

- 1 one-and-a-half inch binder

For Judaic Studies:

- 1 one-inch binder
- 1 package of 5 dividers

For Hebrew:

- 1 small pencil case
- 1 one-inch binder with rings along the spine (can be opened from right to left)

6th Grade

Please bring the following additional materials to school in a **bag** marked with your child's name. Please **do not** label individual items.

- 1 plastic pencil box (labeled with the child's name)
- 2 1-inch 3-ring binders
- 3 sets of 3-ring binder dividers
- 1 ream of loose leaf college rule notebook paper
- 4 additional packages of sharpened pencils
